

What Can The TDP Do For You?

1. **Provide access to the online voter file** – the Texas Democratic Party owns and maintains a database of all registered voters in the state with their voting history, demographic information, and much more. Access to this system is provided at a minimal cost to all Democratic candidates. For details and pricing information, visit the VAN page <http://www.txdemocrats.org/resources/van/> on our website.
2. **TDP Calendar** – Many campaigns, county parties and Democratic Clubs regularly post their scheduled events on the TDP calendar. So it's a good place to check to find out what's going on. You can also post your campaign's events, invite attendees, and keep track of RSVPs. To post events on the TDP website, go to www.txdemocrats.org and sign up for an account. You will be assigned a user name and password that will allow you to post information.
3. **Provide Resources** – The TDP provides valuable tools for organizing in your district.
